Step 1: Meet a Man:

- 1. **PICK** three (3) men (*pray about it*) download a detailed description of the **Me & 3 Brothers' Keepers Model** <u>http://realmenconnect.com/real-men-resources/</u>
- 2. **STICK** with three (3) men (keep in contact with them, pray for them, share resources with them, congratulate them, thank them, etc.)
- 3. **INVITE** a man to any social activity (depending on <u>his</u> level of comfort and risk)
 - <u>1st Level Invite</u>: public meeting (lunch/coffee), event/outing (ex. ball game, car show, bowling, trade show anything/any place where there are <u>other</u> people around).
 - <u>2nd Level Invite</u>: personal event (yours or theirs) (*ex. dinner/cookout at your home, watch ballgame at your house, helping them move, build/repair something, yard work, etc.*)
 - <u>3rd Level Invite</u>: group event (ex. league softball or basketball team/other group sport, dads and daughters' event, father and sons' event, group seminar/workshop, etc.)
 - **4th Level Invite:** ministry event (ex. church service, bible study, men's group meeting/challenge, men's retreat, men's breakfast, prayer group, etc.)
 - <u>5th Level Invite</u>: mission event (*ex. mission trip, serving/feeding the homeless, prison ministry, disaster relief project, community evangelism, etc.*)

Step 2: Measure Your Men:

- 1. **IDENTIFY** a man/men who's <u>hungry</u> (to grow spiritually), <u>humble</u> (to learn more about being a godly man), and <u>honest</u> (willing to share his struggles) ask God to help you identify him/them (4 or 5 men).
- 2. **APPROACH** him/them about possibly joining a weekly <u>Every Man a Warrior</u> (or other type of discipleship group) with you, and ask him to WATCH these three videos to help him decide:

- 3. **FOLLOW UP** with him/them to see if he's interested and the best day (weekend or weekday) and time (am/pm) for him to meet.

Step 3: Make a Disciple:

- 1. **CONFIRM** the 4 (you and 3 others) who've agreed to start an EMAW (or similar) discipleship group.
 - You (leader): create a group text list, so you can keep in contact with your group
 - You (leader): send them the link to buy the kit (or give them one) <u>http://tinyurl.com/everymanawarrior</u>
 - You (leader): request their email addresses, so you can keep in contact with your group
 - You (leader): secure a place and time to meet weekly (i.e., Starbucks @ 6:30 a.m. on Sat.)
 - You (leader): facilitate the first 9 lessons in Book 1 using the Leadership Guide.
 - You (leader): get the group plugged into <u>RealMenConnect.com</u> (ministry website) and <u>RealMenUniversity.com</u> - (a closed Facebook group for Christian men) - as a resource for training, learning, growing, support, accountability, information, and community.
 - You (leader): be faithful by completing all the assignments and leading by example
 - You (leader): after you complete Book 1 of EMAW, allow another group member to facilitate the group until each guy has had a turn to lead (you no longer lead the group, just participate).
- ENCOURAGE him/them (after you complete Book 2 of EMAW) to start praying and being intentional about identifying at least three other (3) men to start a new group and GIVE your group member a copy of this sheet: The Real Men Connect Disciple-Making Blueprint - <u>http://realmenconnect.com/real-men-resources/</u>
